Hello from Year 1 & 2

Years 1 & 2 have been extremely busy this half term, exploring the story of 'The Great Race'. The Great Race has a theme of Chinese New Year which has been the focus for this half term Literacy. Year 1 & 2 enjoyed reading the story, comparing it to other Chinese New Year stories by finding similarities and differences between them.

During the week between 27th and 31st January we celebrated Chinese New Year. These are some of the crafts we did during that week. We discussed how this year is the year of the Snake and what the Snake symbolized to the Chinese Culture.



Our Science theme for this half term has been Microhabitats. Year 1 & 2 have really enjoyed their learning about Microhabitats and food chains. We started the term off by exploring our school to find out what kind of Microhabitats we have around the area.

We were able to then transfer and extend our learning about minibeasts into our new learning by learning about where different minibeasts like to live and why they chose to live in the place that they do. Later on, in the half term we move on by looking at food chains and how all living things depend on other living things for survival.

To end of our learning about microhabitats, we went on a microhabitat outing to Green Mountain which was led by Conservation. Everyone thoroughly enjoyed the session at Green Mountain and had lots of fun exploring its Microhabitats.



During our Art lessons we had lots of fun experimenting with colour by blending to create sunset backgrounds. Everyone did an amazing job practicing their blending skills using different resources such as sponges and paintbrushes. Here are some of our creations.
